This telephone survey was designed by Community & Public Health and conducted by the Cancer Society during April & May 2014. 800 households were contacted and 445 completed the survey.









Key Messages

- Support is high for Smokefree community spaces.
- People supported the idea of Smokefree children's playgrounds, building entrances and outdoor eating areas.
- The public would be MORE LIKELY to visit these community spaces if they were Smokefree.
- Nearly two thirds of respondents did NOT KNOW that their council had a Smokefree policy for parks and/or playgrounds.

Limitations of the Survey

Despite our best efforts, those who responded to our survey were more likely to be: Over the age of 65, Women, and Non Smokers.
